4. Shipping Policies. Company ships orders via UPS and Unites States Postal Service

depending on the location of the shipment and order placement. Depending on product availability, orders are usually processed for shipment within 1 to 3 business days. Accurate shipping address and phone number are required. Your signature may be required for delivery.

5. Delivery Confirmation. Because many instances may occur at your delivery address that is beyond our control, you agree that any delivery confirmation provided by the carrier is deemed sufficient proof of delivery to the card holder, even without a signature.

6. Return and Cancellation Policy.

Customer Sales

Pruvit offers a one hundred percent (100%) ninety-day money back guarantee for all Customers. If a Customer purchased a product or service through a Pruver's website and is not satisfied with the product or service, the Customer may request a refund from their Pruver.

Pruver Purchases

If you are not 100% satisfied with our products or are unable to sell them, you may return the items for a refund if neither you nor we have terminated the Agreement and the products or services were purchased within twelve (12) months and remain in resalable condition. The refund shall be ninety percent (90%) of the purchase price. Shipping and handling charges incurred will not be refunded.

Upon cancellation of the Agreement, the Pruver may return all generic sales aids purchased within one (1) year from the date of cancellation for a refund if he or she is unable to sell or use the merchandise. A Pruver may only return sales aids he or she personally purchased from the Company under his or her Pruver Identification Number, and which are in Resalable condition. Any custom orders of printed sales aids (i.e. business cards, brochures, etc.) whereon the Pruver's contact information is imbedded or hard printed, or has been added by the Pruver, are not able to be returned in resalable condition thus are nonrefundable.
